MCCUSA Proposed Standard

Standard of Perfection - MALE and FEMALE

Disqualifications: Any appearance of rust (copper) in plumage; more than 50% blue in plumage.
(See General Disqualifications and Cutting for Defects.)

Comb, Face, Wattles, & Ear-Lobes: Bright red

Beak: Hown with some black shading permitted

Eyes: Reddish bay

Plumage: Slaty blue and white that has a faint bluish gray tinge. Blue in feathers in the form of large irregular shaped blobs of color as distinct from V-shaped ticking. Main tail feathers and primary wing feathers with a lesser amount of blue than the rest of the plumage.

Shanks and Toes: Light slate, pinkish color showing between scales; bottoms of feet pinkish.
