The White Variety was accepted by the American Poultry Association in January 2014 in West Springfield, Massachusetts

Standard of Perfection - MALE and FEMALE

Disqualifications: All defects and disqualification for white plumage will apply.
(See General Disqualifications and Cutting for Defects.)

Comb, Face, Wattles, & Ear-Lobes: Bright red.

Beak: White

Eyes: Reddish bay.

Plumage: Web, fluff and shafts of all feathers , in all sections, white.

Shanks and Toes: Pinkish white.
